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Participant should:

- 1. Read and carefully consider all materials and/or information provided by the adviser that relates to safety, health, legal, environmental, political, cultural, and/or religious conditions in the area where you will be going.
- 2. Make available to the adviser accurate and complete physical and mental health information and any other personal data that is necessary in planning for a safe and healthy trip.
- 3. Assume responsibility for all the elements necessary for personal preparation for the program and participate fully in orientation.
- 4. Obtain and maintain appropriate insurance coverage and abide by any conditions imposed by the carriers.
- 5. Understand and comply with the terms of participation, codes of conduct, and emergency procedures of the program and obey the law.
- 6. Beware of local conditions and customs that may present health or safety risks when making daily choices and decision. Promptly express health or safety concerns to the staff adviser.
- 7. Behave in a manner that is respectful of the rights and well being of others, and encourage others to behave in a similar manner.
- 8. Accept responsibility for your own decisions and actions.
- 9. Follow the program policies for keeping program staff informed of participants whereabouts and well being.
